As outlined in our bylaws, the responsibilities of the BVLA Commissioner shall be to:

Schedule and contract officials for all High School contests of BVLA Clubs	Schedule Officials for Youth contests as available
Work with official associations and/or individual officials to upgrade performance	Maintain officials assigning platform with contact information, game schedules and update on timely manor
Act and communicate with Clubs and teams on official's game report as related to playing conditions, unsportsmanlike behaviors, ejections	Arrange and schedule BVLA meetings with Principals and Working Committees
Attend BVLA BOD and as needed working committee meetings	Order conference awards
Clarify all by-law interpretation whenever necessary.	Develop an annual BVLA conference meeting schedule
Prepare an annual budget for the conference.	Record minutes at all BVLA BOD meetings
Collect and maintain minutes and records from Working Committees	Perform such other duties as may be assigned by the BVLA BOD
With BOD approval, expenses incurred by the commissioner in transacting business of the BVLA will be assumed by the BVLA.	

The selected commissioner may select/hire someone to fulfill some of these responsibilities with the approval of the BVLA Board of Directors.

This is a paid position via a stipend. This is not an employment relationship with the BVLA, this would be considered an independent contractor (1099 Form) for tax purposes.
